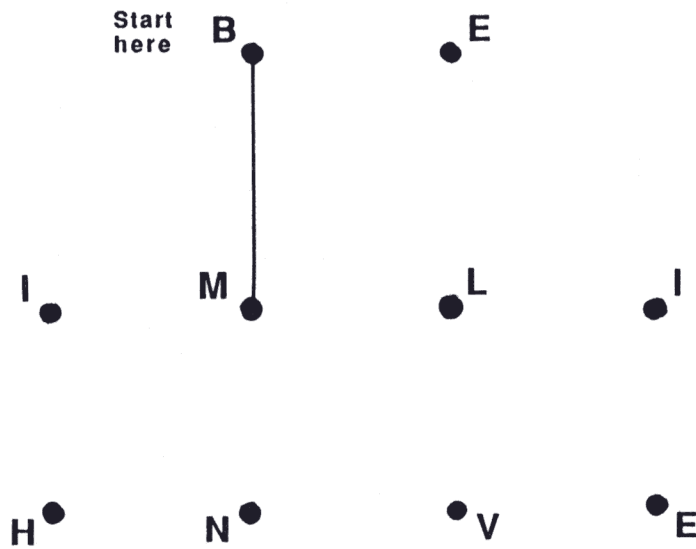


Why Jesus Died
